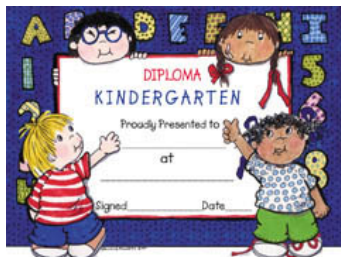

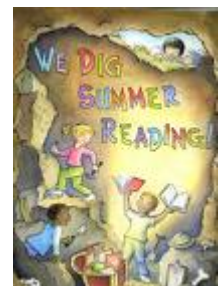

**INFORMATION:**

**FROM THE NURSE:** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have made chickenpox a reportable disease. This means if your school age child is diagnosed with chickenpox, you must report it to the school nurse. The nurse is required to report cases each month to the Chester County



Health Department. This allows them to document and monitor the impact and effectiveness of a vaccination program for chickenpox. Your cooperation is essential for them to make accurate assessment of the program.

## **SCHOOL BUSSING:**

School District regulations state that the child must be picked up and dropped off at the same bus stop - morning and afternoon, that includes if the child is being bussed to a babysitter, day care center, etc...

If your child is going to someplace other than your home address contact the school office for a "Change of Transportation form" which needs to be filled in and returned to the office to be processed for your change. All forms must be into the office no later than June 1, 2010.

Those in the Coatesville School District will receive a card through the mail around the end of August giving you your child's bus stop, time of pick-up and drop-off.
